We know you know what you're doing and don't need us to interfere but as we have said we really do care and just feel better offering our opinion. We want to ensure that you are confident in caring for it. As a suggestion we would recommend you quarantine your new fish and give the fish a bit of R&R.

'NEW FISH' CARE GUIDE

Ideal conditions for the fish to recoup and recover from their journey would be:

Water Temp
Degrees Celsius

PH Range

Ammonia
& Nitrite

18° 7.0
TO
8.5 0

We also recommend plenty of aeration to add oxygen to your pond water. If you're an expert and have the equipment to measure salinity you could have the pond water salted to a percentage of 0.3%. It's now worth double checking your water **before** you introduce the fish.

Once you're happy that your pond water will allow the fish to thrive, we suggest that you place the bag with fish still sealed inside into the pond for half an hour to allow the water in the bag to reach an equilibrium with the pond water. Carefully empty the fish into your pond making sure that you don't damage its protruding fins and tail.

We know you can't wait to get to know your new fish but it's best to observe them and leave them in peace for a few days whilst maintaining your ponds water quality.
